## Errata

At the event, the Do Bugs Need Drugs? Program was erroneously described as beginning in British Columbia. In fact, the program was founded by Dr. Edith Blondel-Hill and began as a small six-month pilot in Grande Prairie, Alberta, Canada in 1998-99. The program now runs in both Alberta (Alberta Health Services) and British Columbia (BC Centre for Disease Control).

As well, SH-SS was described as being the only RHA to have met the stewardship accreditation standard (ROP). Rather, it was the first RHA to pass Accreditation Canada's AMS ROP.
