WHAT CAN HAPPEN

When medications are thrown in the *garbage*, in the *sink*, or flushed down the *toilet*

ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTION

PHARMACEUTICALS can leach into the environment causing:

soil contamination

drinking water contamination

harm to marine life

Water treatment systems are often

NOT capable of completely filtering out
medication residues.

ANTIMICROBIAL RESISTANCE

ANTIBIOTICS are one of the most commonly found medications in **drinking and waste water.**

The accumulation of **ANTIBIOTICS** and other antimicrobial agents in the environment can contribute to **antimicrobial resistance** (*AMR*).

Annual deaths due to AMR infections are estimated to rise to 10 million annually by 2050.
