PRINCIPLES GROUNDING THE MODEL

- Indigenous primary health care services are more likely than mainstream services to improve the health of indigenous communities because:
 - They are generally controlled by their local communities and are therefore underpinned by the values and principles of the communities they serve;
 - They generally provide comprehensive programs that incorporate treatment and management, prevention, and health promotion as well as addressing social determinants of health.¹
- 2. Indigenous people often find it difficult to access appropriate mainstream primary health care services.²
- For non-Indigenous organizations serving Indigenous people, the initial focus has to be on building respectful, high quality relationships between the organization and the Indigenous community(ies) they serve.
- 4. Indigenous health programs are more effective when the local Indigenous community is invested in it, considers the program intrinsic to it (sense of ownership), and there is a high level of sustained community participation and leadership in it.⁴
- Cultural safety is an outcome judged by the Indigenous people receiving the service, and requires understanding and redressing power differentials so that the person feels safe, respected and has their needs met.


