
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Land Acknowledgement



The NCCDH is located in Mi'kma'ki, the ancestral and unceded territory of the Mi'kmaq People. This territory is covered by the "Treaties of Peace and Friendship" which Mi'kmaq and Wolastoqiyik (Maliseet) peoples first signed with the British Crown in 1725. The treaties do not deal with surrender of lands and resources but in fact recognize Mi'kmaq and Wolastoqiyik (Maliseet) title and establish the rules for what is to be an ongoing relationship between nations.

Substance Use Health



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








- Is "the insidious practice of dehumanizing others" Dr. Tam, 2019
- Impacts access to and quality of care
- Results from, and perpetuates, criminalization of some substances





Harm Reduction "stamps out stigma"

- Acceptance instead of judgement
- A movement for social justice AND practical activities to reduce harms associated with drug use
- Abstinence not required

Harm Reduction history

- Originated in community with activists and peers
- Reducing harms caused by systems
- Cautionary note: empty statements are harmful


